Greetings

It is our immense pleasure to invite you for the **30th Annual Convention of Indian Society for Veterinary Medicine and the National Symposium**, being organized by the Department of Veterinary Medicine, College of Veterinary Sciences & Animal Husbandry, Central Agricultural University, Selesih, Aizawl, from 1st to 3rd February, 2012.

The **theme** of the Symposium is **"Animal Health vis-à-vis Animal Welfare with application of Biotechnology with special reference to North- Eastern Region"**, highlighting the advancements in biotechnology for the diagnosis, treatment and control of diseases of animals keeping their welfare under consideration in special context to the North- Eastern Region of India. The symposium will provide a platform for the scientists/ faculties and the professionals of veterinary sciences to interact and suggest measures for better health of animals.

The Indian Society for Veterinary Medicine (ISVM) was established in the year 1981. The society has more than 1500 life members across the country. It's membership is open to veterinary professionals with minimum of B.V.Sc & A.H degree. The society is regular in holding its conventions along with National/ International symposia every year.

The CAU and the C.V.Sc & A.H:

Central Agricultural University (CAU), with its head quarter at Imphal, was established by an act of Parliament *"The Central Agricultural University Act, 1992"*. *The university has its jurisdiction over six states of the North- Eastern Region i.e. Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Sikkim and Tripura.* The College of Veterinary Sciences & Animal Husbandry (CVSc & AH) is one of the constituent colleges of CAU, which became functional in the year 1997. The college campus is a hilly terrain at an altitude of 965 meters above the sea level. The College is located at Selesih, North Aizawl, which is 7 km away from the Bus Terminus, Thuampui, Aizawl and 42 km from the Lengpui Airport, Aizawl on the Aizawl-Sihphir-Silchar road.

The Department of Veterinary Medicine, CVSc & AH, Selesih, Aizawl has the mandate of teaching, research and extension in the areas of Clinical and Preventive Veterinary Medicine. Beside the B.V.Sc. & A.H degree programme, the department is also offering M.V.Sc. programme in the discipline of "Veterinary Clinical Medicine". The department has the faculty strength of six.



Welcome to Mizoram:

Mizoram is one of the '*Seven Sister States*' of the North- Eastern Region of India. **Aizawl is the capital city of the Mizoram state**, which has the international boundaries with two neighboring countries - 'Bangladesh' and 'Myanmar'. Evergreen ranges of Mizoram hills with blooms of exotic flora and dense bamboo jungles rise sharply from the plains of Assam in north south direction. The state experiences heavy rain from May to September with little rain in the cold season. Mizoram is a beautiful place due to its dramatic landscape and pleasant climate. *The climate of Aizawl during the ISVM convention period will be moderately cold (13-22°C) with almost dry season, therefore, warm clothing's as per the season will be required.*



How to reach Aizawl?:

Aizawl is well connected by air from Kolkata and Guwahati. Daily flights from Kolkata (3 flights, one each of Air India, Jet Airways and Kingfisher) and Guwahati (2 flights, one each of Air India and Jet Airways) are available. Regular bus services from Guwahati to Aizawl (passing through Shillong and Silchar) are also available which takes almost 20 hrs. Aizawl is 480 km from Guwahati and 160 km from Silchar covering beautiful hilly terrain of the states of Assam, Meghalaya and Mizoram.



The nearest railway station is Silchar, which can be reached by taking a train journey from Guwahati via Lumding. Regular Sumo service (Road journey) is available from Silchar to Aizawl which takes 6 hours. **However it is more convenient to take a road journey from Guwahati to Aizawl.**



Submission of Abstracts:

Abstracts of the Scientific/ Research/Clinical papers are invited for presentation (oral/ poster) during the Symposium. The papers must be based on the original work of the authors and must not have been published. Abstracts not exceeding 200 words (Times New Roman, Fontsize-12) single spaced, in editable MS Word Format adhering to the guidelines of the standard journal, are required to be submitted **online** at "**isvmaizawl2012@gmail.com**" by **31st December 2011**. The acceptance of the abstract will be sent by e-mail after the scrutiny by the Vetting Committee. The abstracts submitted are required to accompany the duly filled registration form.
